Additionally, Waste Efficiency will work cooperatively within the framework of the environmental objectives set by the environmental policies of its clients when engaged in onsite activities.

Having assessed, and where possible quantified, these environmental impacts Waste Efficiency will set objectives to seek to bring about a continuous improvement in its environmental performance through the setting of challenging targets.

The targets will relate to increased recycling of waste materials, landfill diversion and reductions in the hazardous nature of waste arisings.
